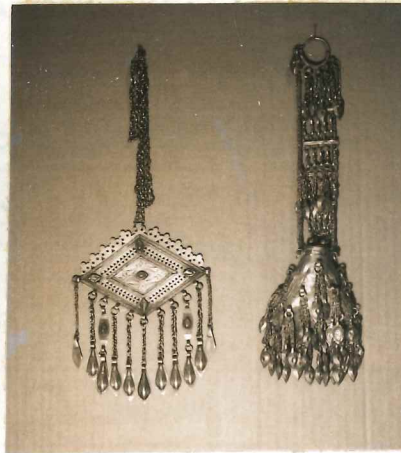

Left: Turkmen breast ornament, gilded and with five cornelians. Twelve "bangles" are suspended from the ornament, two containing cornelians.

Old Turkmen Pendant

The gilded, diamond-shaped breast ornament contains small carnelians at the four corners and in the center. The piece has very finely rendered decoration, including considerable openwork. Eleven “bangles” are suspended from the ornament, two containing carnelians.
