THREE SMALL RUSSIAN RELIGIOUS PENDANTS

Left: A lead cross with flared arms within a ring. The cross is decorated with a central boss, the ring with small notches. There is a suspension ring at the top.
Diameter: 11/16" plus suspension ring 10th c.

Middle: A lead cross within a ring, the cross having bosses in the center and at the ends of the four arms. The top suspension ring is broken.
Diameter: 3/4" plus suspension ring 10th c.

Right: A lead disc displaying a cross within a wreath-like double border, there being a knob at the center and the ends of the arms of the cross. The disc is pierced for suspension.
Diameter: 3/4" 10th c.

The three pieces are from an old collection and are similar to items excavated at Novgorod.
