BRONZE BYZANTINE PENDANT CROSS

The left, right, and bottom arms of the cross are rounded at the ends; the top arm has a suspension ring. The cross bears the incised image of the crucified Christ, wearing the colobium. The heavily patinated cross is of a provincial style and is said to have come from Jordan.
