Two Byzantine Terra Cotta Fragments with the Chi-Rho

Above: Over half of a lamp reflector. In the center is the Chi-Rho monogram (the Rho facing to the left) surrounded by three decorated circles. A letter (an omega?) appears between the left arms of the Chi and there are signs of another letter between the right arms where the original piece was broken in two. From Tunisia.

Approx. 3 1/4" x 2"

Ca. 5th c. A.D.

Below: A detached knob or handle with a border of small circles and displaying at the center the Chi-Rho made of similar small circles. The size of the knob gradually decreases from front to back. From Tunisia.

Diameter at front: 2"

Ca. 4th c. A.D.
