THREE SILVER ETHIOPIAN CROSSES

Left: Large hinged pectoral cross in the form of an interlaced, open-work rectangle, there being a small cross in the center and at the side and bottom "points," and small birds in the spaces between the "points." The small portion above the hinge consists of a broad incised ring fitted to a small incised cross.
