North African Terra Cotta Oil Lamp with Cross

At the top of the lamp is a circular disk with depressed surface pierced by two filling holes. At the center is a cross decorated with alternating diamonds and circles. The disk is outlined by a ridge that extends along the channel to the wick hole. The disk is decorated with alternating six-point "stars" and leaf designs. At the back of the lamp is a stump handle. Probably from Tunisia.
